



HOMEGROWN FILM INTENSIVE AGREEMENT

HomeGrown Film Intensive (HFI) expects students to abide by the Code of Conduct and agree to the terms and conditions listed below. By enrolling you agree to the following.

AGE RESTRICTIONS:

The class is designed for filmmakers ages 15-25. A student older than 25 or younger than 15 may not join the class without written permission from the instructors.

DEFINITIONS:

Suspension -

A suspended student will be asked to leave for the rest of the day. We will have a conversation about their willingness to change their behavior to assess if they will be allowed back the next day.

Expulsion/Expelled -

An expelled student will be escorted out of the class and will not be allowed to return to any additional class days or future intensives.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- HFI expects students to arrive on time each day.
- HFI expects all students to respect each other and their instructor's beliefs by refraining from using swear words, curse words, innuendo, or dirty jokes.
- HFI expects all participants to operate as a team member. Complaining, grumbling, or a poor attitude about contributing to the team's work during the intensive, or disregarding instructions may result in suspension, and if it continues, expulsion.
- HFI expects friendly and constructive discourse between students and instructors. No unkindness, bullying, or belittling others with boasting will be tolerated. Verbal or physical abuse will result in expulsion.
- No drinking of alcoholic beverages, smoking or illegal substances will be allowed during the intensive. Possession of alcoholic beverages, cigarettes, marijuana, or illegal substances, or arriving under the influence of any of these substances will result in immediate suspension or expulsion from the class.
- HFI expects safe and non-destructive behavior. The students will be around and guided to handle tens of thousands of dollars worth of filming equipment and we will be on private property with even more valuable equipment and buildings. Persons engaging in wild behavior, (such as, but not limited to, horsing around, pretending to be careless in jest, engaging in recklessness in the name of "fun" or "joking", using prop weaponry or equipment without permission, using prop weaponry as a "play" weapon) that is deemed a safety hazard to persons or equipment will be given one warning. If the wild behavior continues they will be immediately suspended or expelled from the class. Purposeful destruction of property will result in immediate expulsion from the class.

DAMAGES

Students will be legally responsible for any loss/damages to the facility or property of HFI and the facility or property of any place hosting the class due to their negligence (wild behavior) or deliberate destructive behavior. This financial responsibility must be satisfied within two weeks of the occurrence.

TERMINATION

HFI reserves the right to suspend or expel any student immediately for any reason, should it be deemed necessary for the overall safety and well-being of the students, instructors, equipment or property of HFI. This will be done through written and verbal communication. In the event a student is suspended or expelled, the student will not receive a credit or refund of any monies paid.

CANCELLATION

When you register for HFI, you have the responsibility to attend all dates and times of the class. Our class size is small and the non-attendance of a student affects our ability to run the class effectively. Your seat will not be refunded to you because of a change in your schedule, registering then not attending, skipping attendance on one or more of the days of the class, or cancellation. In the case of an emergency or illness, a partial refund or credit may be available depending on the circumstances.

Purchased seats at the film intensive are non-refundable and non-transferable to other parties. If you have an emergency, please email admin@homegrownfilmintensive.com to let us know.

If the intensive is canceled due to any circumstances, all monies paid to HFI will be refunded. Personal travel costs will not be compensated.

AGREEMENT

1. I agree to abide by the Code of Conduct during my time attending the class.
2. I understand that I will not receive a credit or refund for any monies paid should I engage in behavior breaking the code of conduct that results in my suspension or expulsion from the class.
3. I agree to be legally and financially responsible for any damages committed by my negligence or deliberate destructive behavior.
4. I understand that my seat is non-refundable and non-transferable, and that I am committing myself to attend all 5 days of the class.

INJURY

I will not hold HFI liable for common accidents that happen while attending the class. I understand that it is my responsibility to provide accident and health coverage for myself while I am attending the class, and that I will be responsible for any medical costs that arise outside of healthcare coverage.
